# How it began?

Every story has a beginning, and this one starts with an 8-year-old orphan living in a remote village in Nepal. He was taken to an orphanage, sharing cramped conditions with many other children, destined to become just another statistic. But something extraordinary happened that changed his life forever. At the age of 8, this orphan was fortunate enough to be selected by Asian Aid as one of their first children from Nepal to receive an education in India. In 2004, after completing his education, he returned to Nepal with a mission to contribute to Nepali society.



From a young age, he was sponsored by an Australian university student, Peter Sandy, through Asian Aid. They still keep in touch regularly.

## 3 Angels Nepal is born

The orphan boy, Dr. Rajendra Gautam, never forgot the hope Asian Aid gave him, nor the feeling of being a lost, abandoned child facing a terrifying future of poverty.

## 3 Angels Nepal's First Work

The story of 3 Angels Nepal begins with a blind girl, Meena Gurung, whose grandfather could no longer care for her. Found on the streets of Pokhara, Meena inspired Rajendra and Sarah, who had not planned to start an orphanage. Within five months, they had rescued five girls, housing them in their small two-bedroom rented home. Sarah, a nurse who had witnessed the effects of human trafficking while working in a Kathmandu hospital, was a passionate advocate for women's and children's rights from a young age.

Having lived in an orphanage himself, Rajendra envisioned a home-family model rather than a traditional orphanage. This vision of loving, family-like care is what Rajendra and Sarah wanted to provide for Nepal's orphaned children. Today, 3 Angels Nepal supports over 150 children across 15 children's homes.



# Helen Eager & 3 Angels Nepal

One of the original founders of Asian Aid, Helen Eager, had known Rajendra from his boyhood as an Asian Aid sponsored child. Helen recognised the work of Rajendra and Sarah and was very supportive. They had not only rescued many children but had just started a small school to provide the best education possible without caste barriers or the discrimination these children normally suffered.

Helen saw they were helping these children like a family and advocated for Asian Aid to partner with 3AN and sponsor children in the new school and children's homes.

Helen was known to all as "Mummy Eager" and was indeed a supportive 'Other Mum' to Rajendra and thousands of other Nepali orphans. Today she spends many months every year living in Nepal, working to help the needy children of Nepal, although now retired from Asian Aid Australia.

Over the past year, we have continued to expand our rescue, prevention and rehabilitation efforts across Nepal. Through our border monitoring stations, we helped prevent around 12,033 trafficking cases.

Our safe homes offered refuge and healing to 181 survivors. And through 3 Angels School and 3 Angels IfS, we provided quality education and livelihood training to hundreds of children and women from at-risk communities.

Like every year, we faced challenges—political instability, limited resources, and the growing sophistication of trafficking networks. Yet, through God's grace and the tireless efforts of our team and partners, we persisted.

We remain rooted in our mission: to rescue the exploited, restore the broken, and prevent trafficking before it begins. The heart of 3 Angels beats with the stories of transformation—children who now dream again, women who stand tall with economic independence, and communities that are growing stronger every day.

As we step into a new fiscal year, we envision deeper community engagement, broader collaboration with local governments, and the scaling up of our economic sustainability programs. We will continue to walk hand-in-hand with every survivor, believing in their future as we believe in the God who restores. Furthermore, we are also thrilled to announce the initiation of the long-awaited construction of the 3 Angels Mission School (Pokhara Project)—an extraordinary milestone that brings overwhelming joy to the entire 3 Angels Nepal family. This project represents not only the expansion of our educational vision but also a powerful step forward in creating a safe and empowering space for vulnerable women and children. The dream is becoming a reality, and we move forward with deep gratitude to Give Freedom International for leading this project and every individual involved in this important project that gives us unwavering hope.

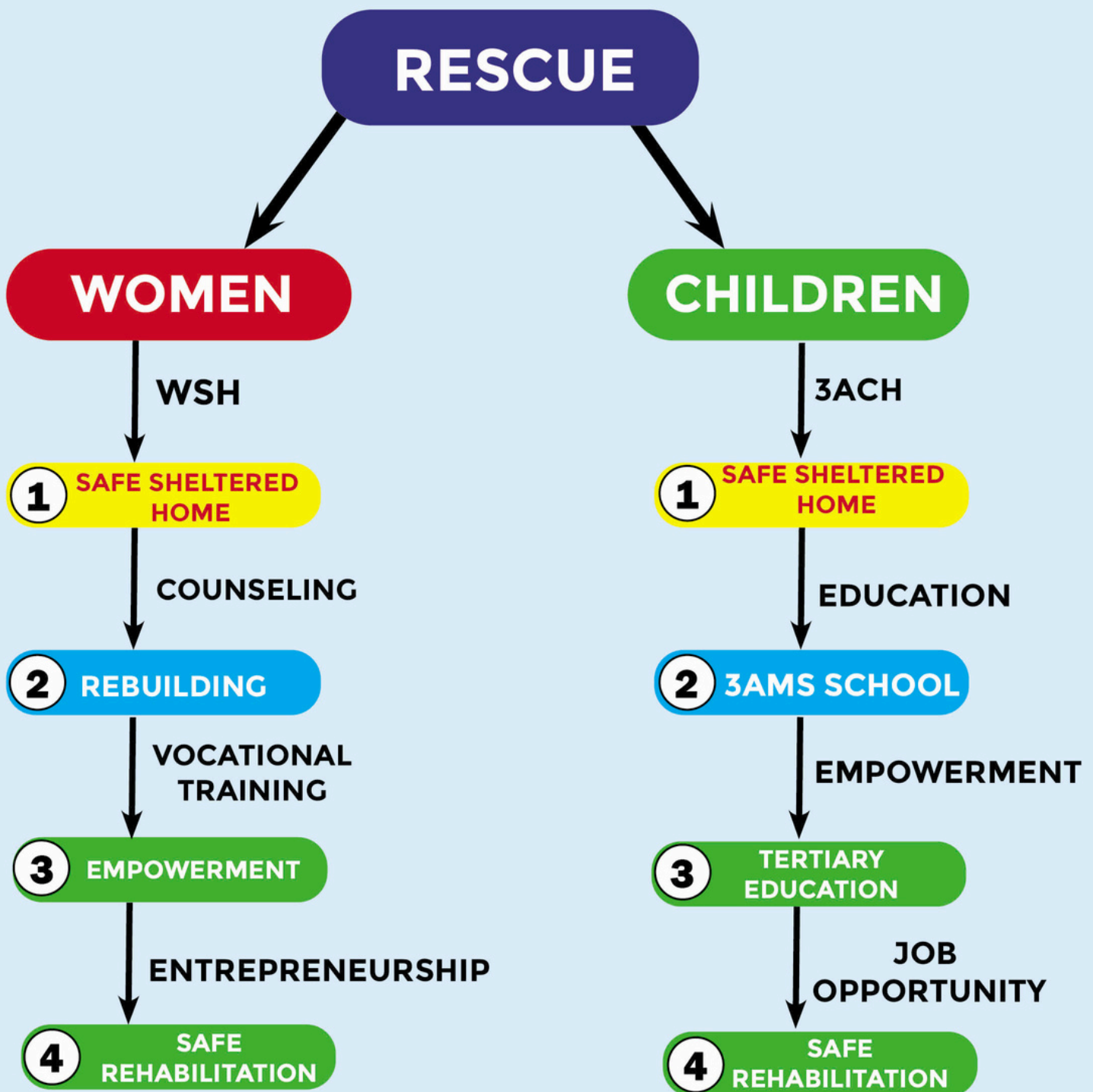

## SOLD TO KUWAIT

Sita, a 35-year-old married woman with only an elementary school education, found herself in a horrific ordeal after being lured by a neighbor with promises of a job in Kuwait. Her husband was working in Oman, making her vulnerable to the enticing offer of "free visa and free flight tickets." This deception led to a month of confinement in Kathmandu.

Eventually, Sita was trafficked to Kuwait, with a 15-day transit stop in Dubai. There, she was held in inhumane conditions, and her passport was confiscated. The presence of other women initially gave her a false sense of security, but her world shattered when she learned she had been sold for 800,000 rupees. She was forced into domestic work in Kuwait, enduring severe physical and verbal abuse, and multiple sexual assaults.

*She endured severe exploitation—denied basic human rights, subjected to violence, and reduced to a commodity with a price tag*

The relentless exploitation took a toll, and Sita collapsed from exhaustion, leading to her return to the agency for replacement. Her treatment at the

agency was no better. Thankfully, she managed to contact her family, and her case was reported to 3 Angels Nepal. Working with the Nepalese

embassy in Kuwait, 3 Angels Nepal successfully rescued Sita, ensuring her safe return to Nepal.

“I was trafficked to Kuwait, but could have been further in trafficking at Saudi Arabia if not for 3 Angels Nepal”

Her story stands as a powerful reminder that no woman should ever be sold, silenced, or forgotten—and that through support, awareness, and action, change is possible.

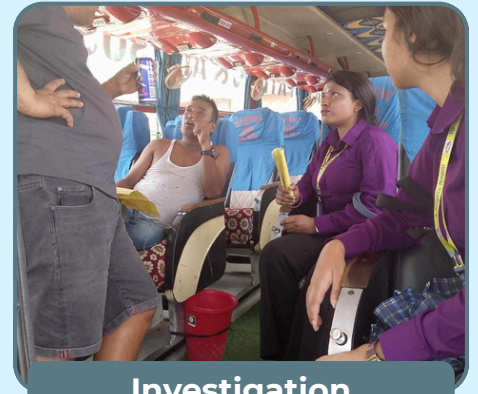

Rescued women undergo life skills and vocational training, while rescued children find refuge in 3 Angels Children Homes. Our safe haven serves not only trafficked women but also individuals identified as acute cases. Complying fully with government standards, our facility is partnered with the provincial government. This year, 241 women successfully completed rehabilitation and returned safely to their communities of origin. Additionally, WSH now provides Certified Technical Education and Vocational Training (CTEVT) in hospitality, cooking, beutician skills, and fashion design to survivors.

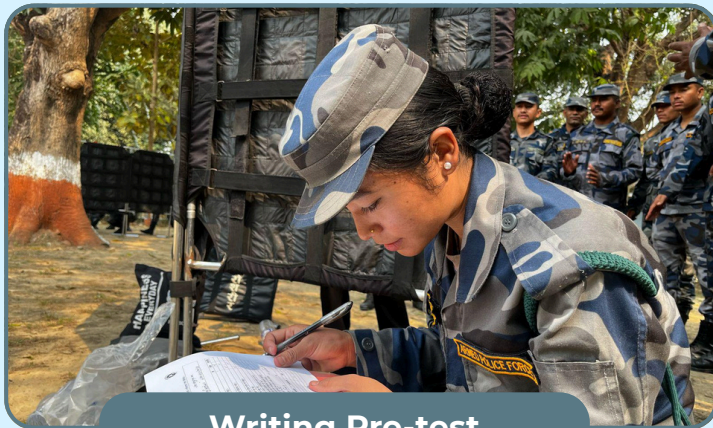
